Liver cancer is the second leading cause of cancer death globally, accounting for **more than 700,000 deaths worldwide** each year.



Hepatitis B and C, Cirrhosis, and NASH increase a person's risk for liver cancer.



Men are **three times more likely** than women to be diagnosed with liver cancer.



Many people diagnosed with liver cancer **did not know they were at risk** of developing the disease.



70% of liver cancer cases **can be prevented** with regular screening.



If you are at risk or think you are at risk for developing liver cancer **talk to your doctor** and make a plan for testing.
